The launch of Ayush Start-up challenge



Ayush Start-up Challenge is a government initiative to identify the start-ups in this field and support them. This challenge covers diverse themes: Ayush Food Innovations, Ayush Bio-instrumentation (Hardware solutions), and Ayush IT Solutions (Software solutions).

The Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi encouraged young people to participate and tweeted: 'The Ayush Start-up Challenge is a great effort to support entrepreneurship in Ayurveda and related sectors. I urge youngsters in the world of start-ups and innovation to take part in it'.

India ranks 2nd for global investment in digital shopping companies

According to research by London & Partners and its analysis of Dealroom.co investment data, India was the second-largest global venture capital investment hub for digital retail startups in 2022, increasing sharply by 175% from US\$ 8 billion in 2020 to US\$ 22 billion in 2021. Bengaluru led the way in terms of worldwide Venture Capital (VC) investments in digital shopping in 2021, with US\$ 14 billion, followed by Gurugram with US\$ 4 billion and Mumbai with US\$ 3 billion. Following a large consumer shift to e-commerce platforms during the pandemic, global venture capital investment in digital shopping more than doubled in 2021. In 2021, total worldwide venture capital investment is estimated to have reached a new high of US\$ 140 billion, up from US\$ 68 billion in 2020.

Digital economy to see exponential growth to \$800 bn by 2030

According to Ms. Nirmala Sitharaman Minister of Finance and Minister of Corporate Affairs, India's digital economy is predicted to rise exponentially to US\$ 800 billion by 2030. She claims that India has over 6,300 fintechs, with 28% specializing in investment technology, 27% in payments, 16% in lending, 9% in banking infrastructure, and over 20% specializing in other industries. She noted that the overall number of retail investor accounts has nearly doubled, rising from around 45 million in March 2016 to 88.2 million by March 31, 2021. The Minister also stated that 75 Digital Banking Units would be established by scheduled commercial banks in 75 districts across the country to commemorate the country's 75th anniversary of independence.

India-UAE trade pact: Bilateral trade projected to touch \$100 bn in 5 years



India and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) inked the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA). Due to this agreement, bilateral goods trade is expected to expand from US\$ 60 billion to US\$ 100 billion yearly within the next five years. In a written reply to the Lok Sabha, Minister of State for Commerce and Industry Ms Anupriya Patel stated that the India-UAE CEPA is a comprehensive and balanced partnership agreement that will provide India with expanded market access in both commodities and services. She stated that the UAE has provided immediate market access at zero duty to products that represent for almost 90% of India's exports to the UAE in value terms, beginning on the first day of the agreement's entry into force. In terms of services trade, the UAE has granted India market access in around 111 subsectors over 11 broad service sectors.
