**Visit of the All-Party Indian Parliamentary Delegation to Brussels  
(03-05 June 2025)**

An All-Party Indian Parliamentary Delegation led by Shri Ravi Shankar Prasad, comprising of Members of Parliament, a former Minister and a former Ambassador is visiting Brussels from 3-5 June 2025. The delegation will have interactions at the European Union level and with Belgian authorities on the scourge of terrorism including cross-border terrorism and the recent heinous terrorist attack in Pahalgam, and India's response to the same, and the country's will and determination to put an end to terrorism in all its forms and manifestations.
