**56th International Film Festival of India**

The Embassy of India in Brussels is pleased to highlight the **56th International Film Festival of India (IFFI) 2025**, taking place in Goa from **20 to 28 November 2025**. IFFI is India's premier annual film festival, bringing together filmmakers, industry professionals, and audiences to celebrate cinema from around the world.

This year, Belgium features prominently at IFFI, reflecting the growing creative partnership between India and Belgium. The festival has selected two notable Belgian-linked films for screening. The first, ***We Believe You***, a compelling Belgian drama directed by Arnaud Dufey and Charlotte Devillers, explores a mother's emotional struggle during a difficult legal battle. The second, ***Enzo***—a French-Belgian-Italian co-production directed by Robin Campillo—follows the transformative journey of a 16-year-old boy as he navigates identity, class, and personal growth. The inclusion of these films underscores Belgium's expanding footprint in global cinema and its increasing engagement with international audiences through festivals such as IFFI.

The Embassy also warmly welcomes **Diane Elbaum**, one of Belgium's leading film producers, who is attending IFFI 2025 as a distinguished guest. Known for her influential work in European independent cinema and her longstanding commitment to artistic storytelling, Ms. Elbaum will participate in key industry engagements at the festival, including panel discussions, masterclasses, and networking sessions focused on co-production opportunities and strengthening creative dialogue between India and Europe. Her presence further enriches the festival's emphasis on collaboration and cross-cultural exchange.

IFFI 2025 offers a dynamic showcase of world cinema, featuring a vibrant opening parade in Panaji, competitive sections such as the International Competition and the ICFT-UNESCO Gandhi Medal, restored classics, immersive VR/AR experiences, and the expanded Film Bazaar, which provides opportunities for global industry networking and partnerships. With Japan as the "Country of Focus" and Spain as the "Partner Country," this year's festival continues to enhance its global engagement.
