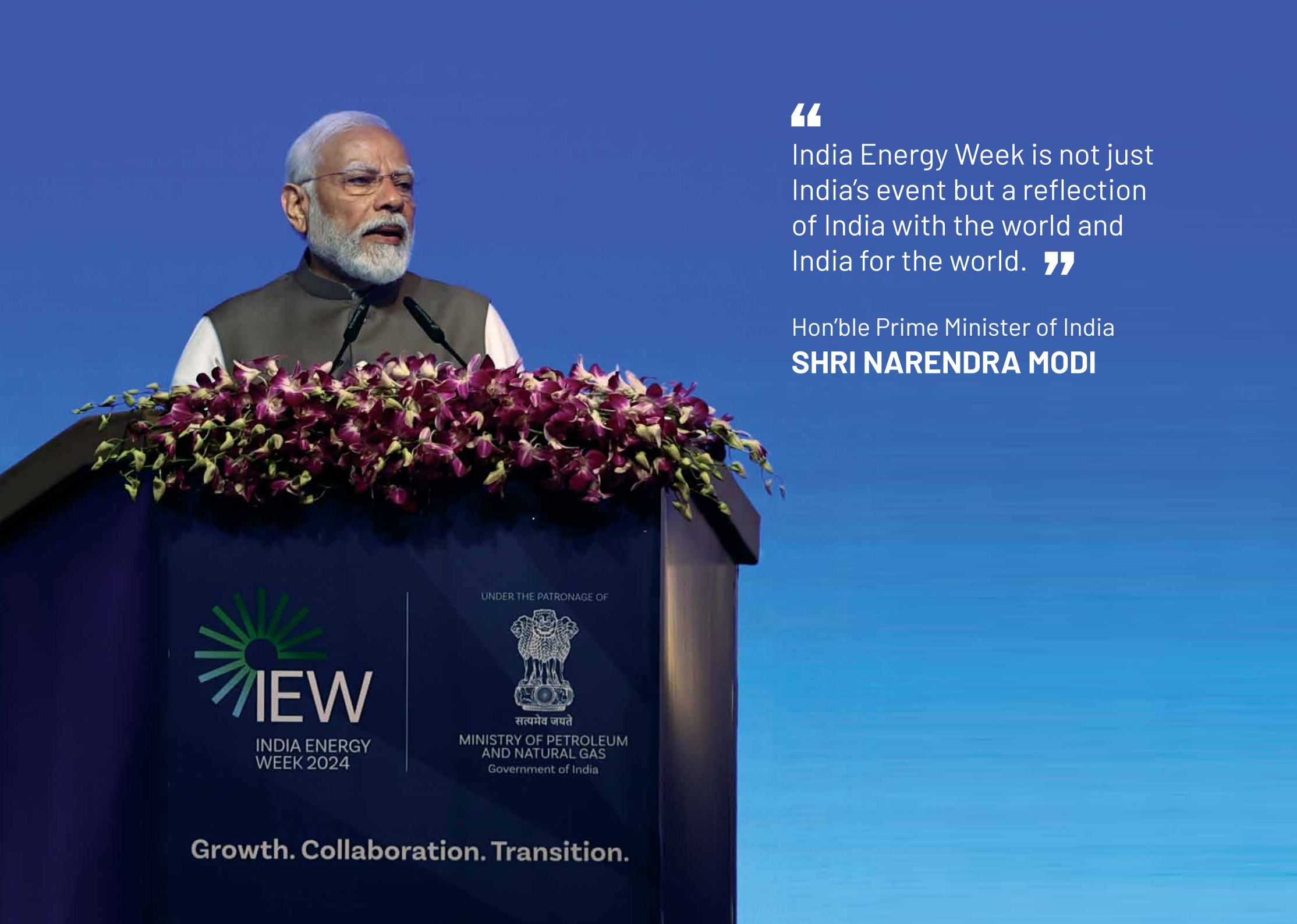

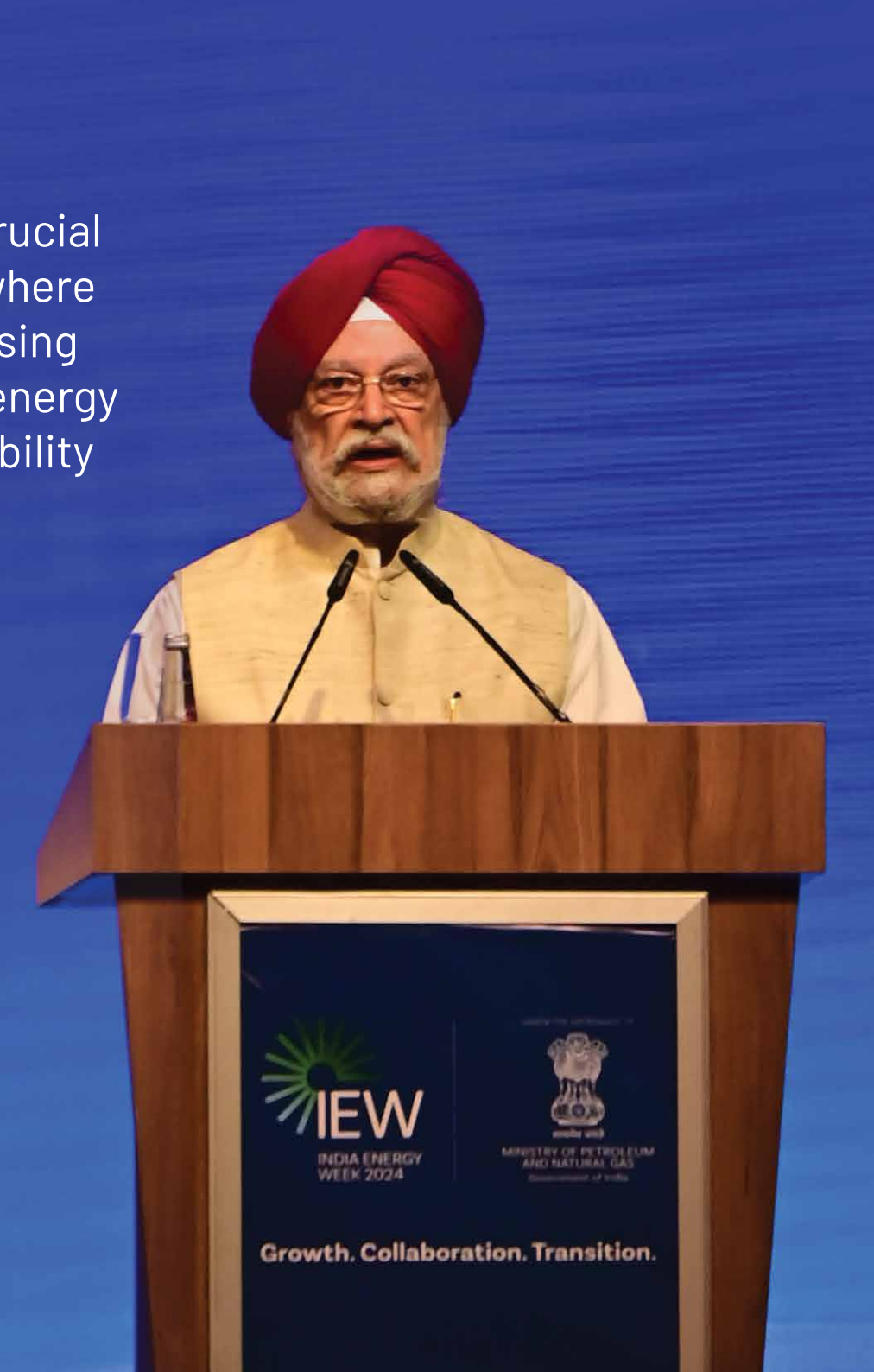

INDIA'S ENERGY TRANSITION

India, the fastest-growing G20 economy, will see surging energy demand in the next decade. The International Energy Agency (IEA) predicts India will account for 25% of global energy growth over the next two decades. This provides India with the opportunity to be a global model of the possible in defining a bespoke, multifaceted energy mix that integrates increasingly decarbonised hydrocarbon sources and that scales deployment of low carbon energy sources like natural gas, renewables, hydrogen and more. Paired with India's substantial, digitally-savvy talent pool to lead the way on critical climate technology development, India is more than equipped for its integral role in the global energy future.

India is expected to balance its energy transition implementation strategy with its agendas for energy security and energy affordability. This will encompass localised supply chains, accelerating green hydrogen production, maximising domestic fuel resources, and prioritising infrastructure and energy efficiency agendas, among other measures. These are complemented by its collaborative initiatives such as the International Solar Alliance (ISA), the First Movers Coalition and the Global Biofuels Alliance.

India has unique natural advantages as well as unique challenges, given its size, scale and ambition. In the pursuit of a sustainable and just energy future, India stands out as both a leader and an example of the path forward.
